Note 1 Applicant should complete a separate Manpower Plan for each works contract (including the works contract under application and the supplementary contract(s) (i.e. the other pre-approved works contract(s) specified in the Standard Employment Contract for which the imported labour will be deployed to work and such contract(s) should be under the applicant))

Note 2 The number in brackets refers to the corresponding number of "trade" in Schedule 1 of the Construction Workers Registration Ordinance.
Note 3 A full-time labour is one who works not less than 35 hours per week. The number filled in is an average number, which is the current plan of the applicant, and may need to be reasonably adjusted having regard to the changes in the construction site and the work sequence during actual implementation.

Note 4 For filling in this form for the works contract under application, it refers to the imported labour applied for. The employment contract of labour imported under the Construction Sector Scheme is up to a maximum of 24 months.
