
Flowchart showing procedures for drainage connection works carried out by owner/developer

Flowchart showing procedures for run-in construction and damaged footway reconstruction works carried out by private developers in conjunction with building development



Developer/AP seeks comments from Transport Department, Traffic Police and other government departments, etc.


Developer/AP cooperates with other parties within the "uncoordinated" case to form a coordinated programme.

Developer/AP submits XP in XPMS or application form (i.e. Form HyD 14) to HyD with the prescribed fee.



Usually takes 5 working days (for XPMS application and by e-payment); 17 working days (for hardcopy submission)
