Means an institution that is exempted from tax under section 88 of the Inland Revenue Ordinance (Cap. 112).

"Person with Disability"	 Means a person with – total or partial loss of the person's bodily or mental functions; or total or partial loss of a part of the person's body; or malfunction, malformation or disfigurement of a part of the person's body; or Registration Card for People with Disabilities issued by the Labour and Welfare Bureau.
"Premises"	Means the Premises as referred to in Clause 1 of the Tenancy Agreement.
"Proponent"	Means a person who submits a proposal in response to the Notice of Proposal Invitation for STT No. SHX 1382; and references to "person" shall include any individuals, companies, joint ventures and partnership of individuals and/or companies.

"Site Area of the Premises"	Means the area of 1,930 sq.m. of the Premises which is set out in the First Schedule to the Tenancy Agreement.

"Supporting Facilities"	Means facilities such as lighting, seating, shading, signage, at grade access, toilets, storage facilities, washing facilities, etc. to support the operation of the Premises so as to facilitate public enjoyment at the Premises.
"Tenancy Agreement"	Means the Tenancy Agreement No. SHX 1382 of the Premises between the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region as the landlord of the
