TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive, I have made an order under sections 17(1)(a) and 17(1)(b) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) (hereinafter referred to as "the Ordinance") as applied by section 26 of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation (Chapter 358, Subsidiary Legislation AL) directing that the existing carriageways, cycle tracks, footpaths, alleys and open spaces, or parts thereof and the Government foreshore or sea-bed at Sheung Yue River (River Beas) and Shek Sheung River (River Sutlej) within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. 60335576/GZ3/400-410 ("the Plans") and described in the scheme annexed thereto, and as amended by Amendment Plans Nos, 60335576/GZ3/400A, 60335576/GZ3/408A, 60335576/GZ3/409A and 60335576/GZ3/410A ("the Amendment Plans") and described in the amendment scheme annexed thereto, which Plans and scheme were referred to in G.N. 10023 published on 31 December 2015 and 8 January 2016, and the Amendment Plans and amendment scheme were referred to in G.N. 6489 published on 18 November 2016 and 25 November 2016 shall be closed temporarily or permanently and reclaimed temporarily, and has further declared under section 17(1)(c) of the Ordinance as applied by section 26 of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation (Chapter 358, Subsidiary Legislation AL) that as from 27 December 2025, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the above existing carriageways, cycle tracks, footpaths, alleys and open spaces, or parts thereof to be permanently closed, shall be extinguished; and from 27 December 2025 to 26 December 2026, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the above existing carriageways, cycle tracks, footpaths, alleys and open spaces, or parts thereof to be temporarily closed and the above Government foreshore or sea-bed at Sheung Yue River (River Beas) and Shek Sheung River (River Sutlej) to be temporarily reclaimed, shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be, during that period.

The sewerage works to be carried out on the above affected existing carriageways, cycle tracks, footpaths, alleys, open spaces, or parts thereof and foreshore or sea-bed mainly involve:—

- (i) construction of the rising mains, gravity sewers, sewage pumping station and associated manholes within the limit of works area as shown on the Plans and Amendment Plans; and
- (ii) ancillary works including reinstatement of carriageways, cycle tracks, footpaths, alleys and open spaces.

A copy of the order, and the Plans and the Amendment Plans showing the above affected existing carriageways, cycle tracks, footpaths, alleys, open spaces, or parts thereof and foreshore
