SEWERAGE WORKS UNDER PWP ITEM NOS. 7899CL AND 7852CL-2 (PART)  
DEVELOPMENT OF SAN TIN TECHNOPOLE PHASE 1 WORKS—  
SITE FORMATION AND ENGINEERING INFRASTRUCTURE

TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive, I have made an order under section 17(1)(a) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) (hereinafter referred to as ‘the Ordinance’) as applied by section 26 of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation (Chapter 358, Subsidiary Legislation AL) directing that the existing carriageways, footpaths, cycle tracks, amenity areas and central medians/refuge islands, or parts thereof within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. 60670882/GAZ/400 and 60670882/GAZ/404 (“the Plans”) and described in the scheme annexed thereto, which Plans and scheme were referred to in G.N. 1244 published on 8 March 2024 and 15 March 2024, shall be temporarily closed, and has further declared under section 17(1)(c) of the Ordinance as applied by section 26 of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation (Chapter 358, Subsidiary Legislation AL) that as from 1 May 2026 to 30 April 2027, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the above existing carriageways, footpaths, cycle tracks, amenity areas and central medians/refuge islands, or parts thereof to be temporarily closed, shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be, during that period.

The sewerage works to be carried out on the above affected existing carriageways, footpaths, cycle tracks, amenity areas and central medians/traffic islands involve:—

- (i) construction of about 3 400 metres of gravity sewers and associated manholes within the limit of works area as shown on the Plans;
- (ii) construction of about 650 metres of twin rising mains and associated manholes and sewage outlet within the limit of works area as shown on the Plans;
- (iii) construction of a sewage pumping station within the limit of works area as shown on the Plans; and
- (iv) ancillary works including temporary closure and reinstatement/reconstruction of existing carriageways, footpaths, cycle tracks, amenity areas and central medians/refuge islands.

A copy of the order and the Plans showing the above affected existing carriageways, footpaths, cycle tracks, amenity areas and central medians/refuge islands, or parts thereof may be inspected by members of the public, free of charge, at the following locations and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:—

This notice will be affixed on or near the above affected existing carriageways, footpaths, cycle tracks, amenity areas and central medians/refuge islands on 24 April 2026.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation (Chapter 358, Subsidiary Legislation AL) may serve upon the Secretary for Environment and Ecology a written claim, before the expiration of one year from the date of closure, extinction, modification or restriction, which can be submitted *via* one of the following means:—

Personal Information Collection Statement

The provision of any information, including the personal data, as required under Part VI of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation (Chapter 358, Subsidiary Legislation AL) is obligatory. If such information, including the personal data, as required under Part VI of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation (Chapter 358, Subsidiary Legislation AL) is not provided as requested, the claims may be rejected. Any information, including the personal data, so submitted may be disclosed to the relevant government departments and other persons, organizations or agencies which are required to handle the claims and related matters. Persons who have so submitted their personal data have the rights to request access to and correction of their personal data in relation to their claims.
