TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive, I have made an order under section 17(1)(a) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) (hereinafter referred to as “the Ordinance”) as applied by section 26 of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation (Chapter 358, Subsidiary Legislation AL) directing that the existing carriageways, footpaths, and open spaces, or parts thereof, within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. 5125001-GAZ-ST-001, 5125001-GAZ-WYH-001, 5125001-GAZ-CH-001, 5125001-GAZ-CH-002 and 5125001-GAZ-SKC-001 (“the Plans”) and described in the scheme annexed thereto, and as amended by Amendment Plan No. 5125001-GAZ-WYH-002 (“the Amendment Plan”) and described in the amendment scheme annexed thereto, which the Plans and the scheme were referred to in G.N. 3466, 3467 and 3468 published on 8 July 2022 and 15 July 2022, and the Amendment Plan and the amendment scheme were referred to in G.N. 898 published on 10 February 2023 and 17 February 2023 shall be temporarily closed, and has further declared under section 17(1)(c) of the Ordinance as applied by section 26 of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation (Chapter 358, Subsidiary Legislation AL) that as from 4 October 2026 to 3 October 2027, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the above existing carriageways, footpaths and open spaces, or parts thereof to be temporarily closed, shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be, during that period.

The sewerage works to be carried out on the above affected existing carriageways, footpaths and open spaces or parts thereof involve:—

- (i) construction of about 4 600 metres of gravity sewers and associated manholes within the limit of works area as shown on the Plans and Amendment Plan; and
- (ii) ancillary works including temporary closure and reinstatement of affected existing carriageways, footpaths and open spaces.

A copy of the order, and the Plans and the Amendment Plan showing the above affected existing carriageways, footpaths, and open spaces or parts thereof may be inspected by members of the public, free of charge, at the following locations and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:—

This notice will be affixed on or near the above affected existing carriageways, footpaths, and open spaces or parts thereof on 18 September 2026.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation (Chapter 358, Subsidiary Legislation AL) may serve upon the Secretary for Environment and Ecology a written claim, before the expiration of one year from the date of closure, extinction, modification or restriction, which can be submitted *via* one of the following means:—

Personal Information Collection Statement

Any information, including the personal data, submitted to the Secretary for Environment and Ecology in connection with any written claims served under Part VI of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation (Chapter 358, Subsidiary Legislation AL) will be used for the processing of the claims and other related purposes. The provision of any information, including the personal data, as required under Part VI of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation (Chapter 358, Subsidiary Legislation AL) is obligatory. If such information, including the personal data, as required under Part VI of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation (Chapter 358, Subsidiary Legislation AL) is not provided as requested, the claims may be rejected. Any information, including the personal data, so submitted may be disclosed to the relevant government departments and other persons, organizations or agencies which are required to handle the claims and related matters. Persons who have so submitted their personal data have the rights to request access to and correction of their personal data in relation to their claims.
