Tuen Ma Line Phase 1, i.e. extending the existing Ma On Shan Line to three new stations, namely Hin Keng, Diamond Hill and Kai Tak stations, was commissioned on 14 February 2020. The works for Tuen Ma Line was on schedule. All the suitable measures at and near the Hung Hom Station Extension were completed in June 2020 and the associated architectural builder's works and finishes, electrical and mechanical systems and fire services installation works were in progress. The track and overhead line reinstatement works were completed. The target commissioning of the "Kai Tak to Hung Hom Section" remains as Q3 2021. Since October 2019, there had been multiple damages to the East Rail Line (EAL) facilities necessitating emergency inspections, maintenance and cancellation of works originally planned during non-traffic hours. The MTRCL had replaced the damaged facilities and completed the re-installation works. There was system reliability issue during a test for the new signaling system of EAL. The Government was aware of the issue in September 2020 and requested MTRCL to suspend the commissioning of new EAL signaling system. The Government contended that after further ascertaining system reliability, it could consider whether the new EAL signaling system should be put into service.
