
Quarterly Report on the Public Works Programme

The Quarterly Report on the Public Works Programme (PWP) provides information on the progress of selected "high impact Category A" projects.

Projects included in this report are selected having regard to their cost, importance, complexity and other factors which suggest that they may be of interest to the public. Key information including project estimates, start and completion dates as approved by the Finance Committee, together with a Note on Progress, is given for each project.

In the quarter ending June 2016, two projects were completed. These projects are no longer included in this report. In the quarter ending September 2016, another six projects were completed. These latter projects will be excluded from the next Quarterly Report onwards. Lists of the above-mentioned projects are shown in the Appendix.

As such, the HyD anticipated that the related subsequent works could not be completed within the same year. In other words, the CWB could not be commissioned in 2017 as originally scheduled. The HyD together with their consulting engineer and resident site staff will continue to closely monitor the works progress of the CWB project and will duly assess the schedule of works with the aim of commissioning the CWB as early as possible.
