# Works Bureau Technical Circular No. 5/2000 Works Subject to Excision in Tender Evaluation

## **Scope**

This Circular sets out the policy in tender evaluation for tenders which contain work subject to excision.

## **Effective Date**

2. This Circular takes immediate effect.

### **Effect on Existing Circulars**

3. This Circular is to be read in conjunction with L&WTC No. 6/89 and WBTC No. 24/98.

#### **Background**

4. As given in L&WTC No. 6/89, where work is to be included in a tender but the implementation of that work has not been decided upon by the Employer, then such work must be incorporated as a Section Subject to Excision in the contract.

#### **Policy**

5. If by the time a tender recommendation is made, the Government has decided not to proceed with the work contained within the Section(s) Subject to Excision, then the tender price for such section(s) shall be discarded and the net tender value shall be taken for the purposes of tender evaluation.
