We refer to your letter dated 6 August 2012.

- In the first place, we would repeat our position that in the absence of the government lease, it is not open to Government to make the assumption that the above lot is subject to the terms and conditions as stated in GN No.278 of 1911.
- In response to your proposition that "human remains" would include "ashes from burning of a human body, and ashes from cremation are no less to be regarded as human remains", our client has been advised that "human remains" does not include cremated human ashes for the following reasons:-
 - As a matter of plain English, "remains" in the context of "human remains" 3.1 means what is left behind in a passive state after a natural process of organic decomposition of the human body over time, mainly by bacterial actions, without any human or artificial intervention to accelerate the process. On the other hand, production of cremated ashes from the human body requires active human intervention by a process of combustion.

- 3.2 Human remains will retain a significant part of human characteristics. For instance, human identity may still be traceable by laboratory examination of the DNA of the human remains. However, upon reduction of cremated human body to ashes after the process of cremation, no human characteristics may be traceable. The end product of cremation is inorganic substances, essentially indistinguishable visually or by chemical composition as to whether they are of human or animal origin. Indeed, being inorganic substances, cremated ashes may not even have any evidence of the pre-existing life form from which they are derived.
- 3.3 When Special Condition No.5 in GN 278 ("Special Condition No.5") was introduced in 1911, earth burials in grave or deposits of human remains in earthenware above ground were already prevalent in the New Territories, which Special Condition No.5 was no doubt designed to address. In stark contrast, there were hardly known instances of cremation of human bodies then. Cremated ashes being inorganic substances, their interment or deposit will not give rise to hygienic or sanitation problem. Hence, it is highly unlikely that they came under the purview of Special Condition No.5.
- 4. In the circumstances, we do believe that the warning of re-entry action given in your letter under reply is premature. In order to establish the right of re-entry, there are at least the following two hurdles for Government to surmount:-
 - 4.1 As a matter of fact, to adduce satisfactory evidence to prove that Special Condition No.5 applies to the lot.
 - 4.2 As a matter of law, to establish that the meaning of "human remains" in Special Condition No.5 includes cremated human ashes.
- 5. We are instructed by our client that it will vigorously challenge both two issues of law and fact as above stated. Should you still consider re-entry action as an ultimate measure of lease enforcement notwithstanding our foregoing submission, we would respectfully suggest that the Court be invited to rule on these two issues as part of the way forward.

Lot No. 559 in D.D. 131

I refer to your letters to the District Lands Office, Tuen Mun dated 25 August 2010, 24 September 2010 and 21 February 2011 respectively, which have been passed to me with instructions to reply.

Lot No. 559 in D.D. 131 (hereinafter referred to as "Lot No. 559") was sold by auction, notice of which was published in G.N. S. 76 of 1918, subject to the General Conditions in G.N. 365 of 1906 and Special Condition No. 5 in G.N. 278 of 1911.

Special Condition No. 5 in G.N. 278 of 1911 (hereinafter referred to as "Special Condition No. 5") provides that "Without the consent of the District Officer no grave shall be made on, nor shall any human remains be interred in, or deposited on the land sold either in earthenware jars or otherwise, and a covenant to this effect shall be inserted in the Crown Lease of the Lot."

Our interpretation of "human remains" would include ashes from the burning of a human body. Ashes from cremation are no less to be regarded as human remains. Any operation involving deposit or storage of human remains will amount to a breach of Special Condition No. 5.

For the reasons stated aforesaid, it is the Government's position that your client's operation of niches/columbarium on Lot No. 559, if any, is prohibited and amounts to a breach of the lease.

I hereby give your client a warning that if Lot No. 559 is found to be used as columbarium in breach of Special Condition No. 5, lease enforcement action, including but not limited to re-entry action, will be taken against your client without further notice.

All rights of the Government under the lease conditions governing Lot No. 559 are hereby reserved.


