
# Kau Yi Chau and Hei Ling Chau (Artificial islands in the Central Waters to the eastern Lantau)

Improvement to south waterfront







Cheung Sha Beach


- Lower Cheung Sha: Water activities centre (Tourism Commission: Proposed facilities for Spa and Resort facilities)
- Upper Cheung Sha: Natural environment and landscape preserved for swimmers








