Question :

As regards the "Hire of Services and Professional Fees" of Departmental Expenses, the estimated expenditure during 2004-05 is about \$49 million higher than the revised estimate during 2003-04. Can the Administration state the reasons why? Where will such fees be spent on?

Asked by : Hon. YEUNG Yiu-chung

Reply : Compared with the revised estimates 2003-04, there will be an increase of \$49.8 million in 2004-05 for the hire of services and professional fees. The main reasons for the increase are:

- (i) increased outsourcing in the investigation and removal of unauthorized building works (UBW) in progress, large scale clearance of UBW and investigation and monitoring of building repairs, amounting to \$24.2 million;
- (ii) outsourcing part of the enforcement actions to the Housing Authority in respect of backlog removal orders, drainage defects in private buildings and UBW in rear lanes and blackspots, amounting to \$16.3 million; and
- (iii) carrying out consultancy studies on standards of building design and conditions of existing buildings, amounting to \$9.3 million.
